The meeting was opened at 12:17 p.m. by Deputy Mayor Fitch and discussion was had about needing to order a new electric motor for the well house pump #1.

Trustee Gearhart had spoken to Jerome Decker. Electric motor that runs pump #1 is bad. The plan is to get pump #2 up and running and completed. We would than put the motor from pump #2 in well #1. We would be purchasing a 30 horse motor and refurbishing the other motor.

Motion was made by Trustee Lamont to authorize Jerome Decker to purchase a well head motor not to exceed \$7,000. Motion was seconded by Trustee Gearhart and passed unanimously.

There was some discussion about the grant that was received from CWC (Grayden Dutcher) for work in Reservoir Park and the need to apply for additional funding to finish Resevoir Park.

Motion was made by Trustee Gearhart to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Trustee Lamont and passed unanimously.
